\$20 for 5K race week registration

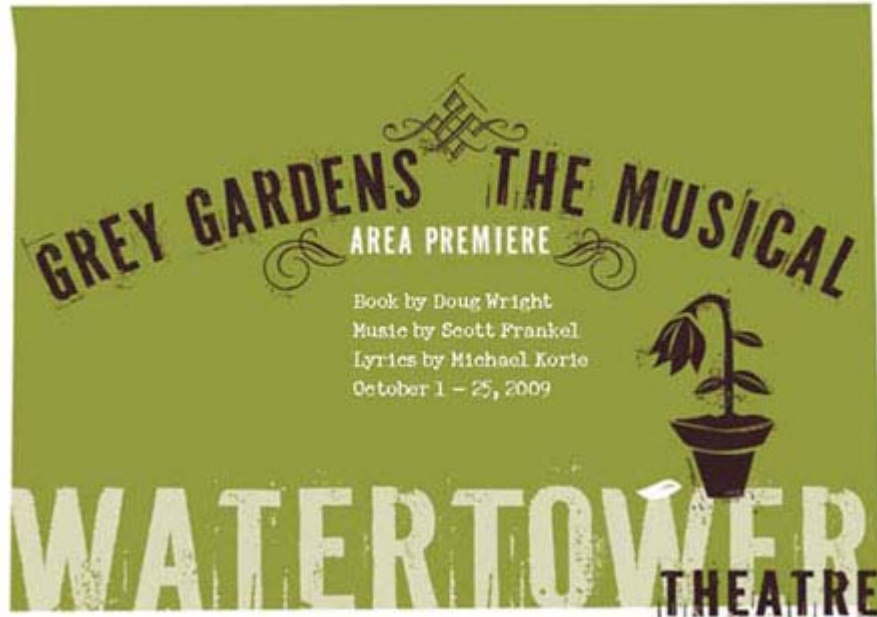

Concert



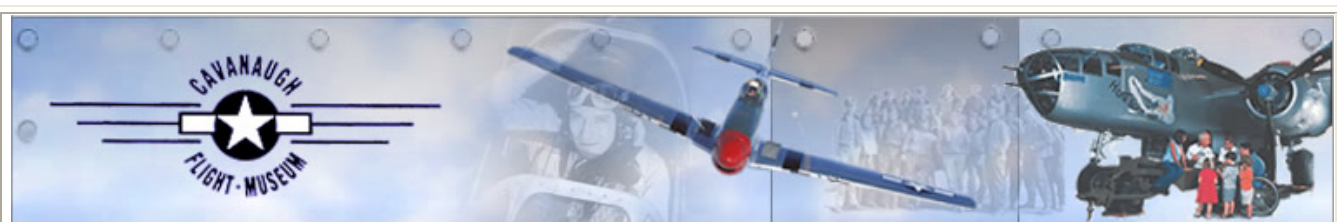
