Council Updates

Upcoming Public Hearings

The following Public Hearings will take place at the March 19 Planning & Zoning Commission meeting at the Addison Conference Centre. The agenda will be posted on the Town's website three days before the meeting.

- **PUBLIC HEARING Case 1910-Z/Addison Circle Station – Phase I Amendment.** Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request to amend Planned Development (PD) Ordinance No. O23-8, for a 13.7± acre property generally located at the southeast corner of Addison Road and Festival Way and the northeast corner of Quorum Drive and Arapaho Road, to allow a transit-oriented mixed-used development comprised of multifamily residential, office, parking, restaurant, retail, and entertainment uses, and associated public and private open space and common areas.
- **PUBLIC HEARING Case 1894-Z/Office & Parking Structure, Addison Circle Station – Phase I Amendment.** Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request to amend the development plans for Planned Development (PD) Ordinance No. O23-9, for a 2.0± acre property located at the southeast corner of Addison Road and Festival Way, to allow for the development of an office building with ground floor retail/restaurant uses, a parking structure, site access drives, and Addison Road and Festival Way streetscape improvements on and adjacent to the development site.
- **PUBLIC HEARING Case 1895-Z/Multifamily Tower, Addison Circle Station – Phase I Amendment.** Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request to amend the development plans for Planned Development (PD) Ordinance No. O23-10, for a 2.3± acre property located at the southwest corner of Quorum Drive and Festival Way, to allow for the development of a multifamily residential tower with ground floor retail/restaurant uses, and Festival Way and Quorum Drive streetscape improvements on and adjacent to the development site.
- **PUBLIC HEARING Case 1906-Z/14295 Midway Road (Westwood Montessori).** Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request for a Special Use Permit (SUP) to allow a Private School on a portion of an 8.67± acre property located south of Proton Drive and approximately 600 feet west of Midway Road (14295 Midway Road), that is currently zoned Planned Development (PD), through Ordinance No. 625.

The Spring Town Meeting has been scheduled for Tuesday, April 2 at 7pm at the Addison Conference Centre. Council will discuss the Key Focus Areas they identified in their recent Strategic Planning Workshop. The meeting will also be live-streamed on the Town's website.

Volunteers Needed for Addison Circle Vision Plan Advisory Committee

The City Council recently approved a professional services agreement with OJB Landscape Architecture to create a Vision Plan for Addison Circle Park. Because public engagement is an important part of this process, the Council is planning to appoint an advisory committee to represent the variety of groups impacted by the park's future. The committee will consist of 14 members with each Council member appointing one Addison resident and one Addison business representative. The time commitment will be 5-7 meetings over a 7-month period. There will also be a benchmark park tour which may require a 1-2 day commitment.

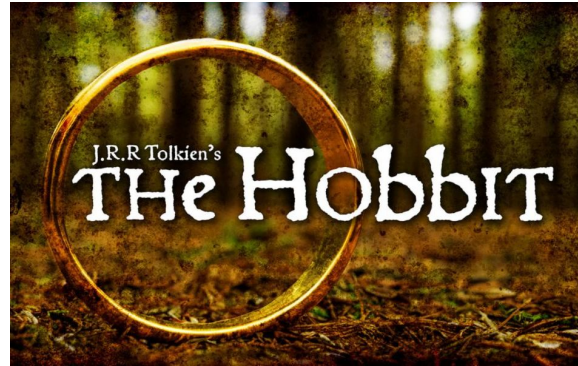
