Upcoming Public Hearings

The following Public Hearings will take place at the March 26 City Council Meeting meeting at the Addison Conference Centre. The agenda will be posted <u>on the Town's website</u> three days before the meeting.

- Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request for a Special Use Permit (SUP) for property located at 5100 Belt Line Road, Suite 800 and 812, that is currently zoned Planned Development (PD), through Ordinance No. 023-03, to allow a restaurant with the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption. Case 1905-SUP/5100 Belt Line Road, Suite 800 & 812 (III Forks).
- Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request for a subdivision variance to install a new overhead electric power pole and supported electric utility infrastructure immediately south of the common property boundary of the Greenhill School campus (4141 Spring Valley Road), 4090 Juliard Drive, and 14604 Vintage Lane, in order to provide electric service to the newly constructed Valdes Stem + Innovation Center on the Greenhill School campus. Case SV2024-01/Greenhill School Subdivision Variance.

Two Closures Planned on Dallas North Tollway This Weekend



The Dallas North Tollway (DNT) will be closed in both directions between Belt Line Road and Keller Springs Road overnight Saturday into Sunday for construction of the DART Silver Line regional rail project. The continued repairs to the Northaven Road bridge will also close southbound DNT between I-635 and Royal Ln. late Friday into early Monday morning. Details of the two closures are below.

Friday, March 22 at 10pm through Monday, March 25 at 5am for Northaven Bridge Repairs

- All lanes of southbound DNT from I-635 to Royal Lane
- East- and westbound I-635 to southbound DNT direct-connector ramps
- Southbound Harvest Hill Rd., Inwood Road, and Forest Lane entrance ramps
- Southbound Royal Lane exit ramp
- Northbound left lane of DNT from Royal Lane to Forest Lane

March 23-24 (10pm to 5 am) for DART Silver Line Construction

- All lanes of southbound Dallas North Tollway (DNT) from the Keller Springs Road/Arapaho Road exit ramp to the entrance ramp from Belt Line Road
- All lanes of northbound DNT from the Belt Line Road/Arapaho Road exit ramp to the entrance ramp from Keller Springs Road
