Odyssey Associates Presents Addison Theatre Study Recommendations

In January of 2024, Addison engaged Odyssey Associates to conduct an Addison Theatre Centre Business Study. At the May 28 City Council meeting, the consultant provided the Council with its recommendations based on information obtained from background reviews, stakeholder interviews, and industry best practices.

Council Discusses New Police and Courts Building and Consolidating Town Hall Departments at the Conference Centre

In July 2019, the Town engaged LPA Architects to conduct a Facility Utilization and Consolidation Study to enhance facility functionality and plan for future growth. The initial report was presented in April 2020, leading the Council to commission a second phase to build on the initial data and provide additional options and financial analysis. The Phase 2 report, presented in the spring of 2023, prompted the Council to focus on new Police and Courts Facility and Town Center options.

At its May 28 meeting, the Council expressed support for tearing down the existing Police and Courts building and building a new facility in the same location. The current building's age, condition, and unknown future repair and upgrades necessitate an expeditious approach to a new building. The estimated cost is \$35 million, and Council will discuss funding in more detail at the next Council meeting.

The Council also indicated support for renovating the Conference Centre and moving the City Manager's Office, Human Resources, and Marketing teams to that building. The project renovation budget is \$2 million and would be funded through a Fiscal Year 24 budget amendment. Finance would move to the current Town Hall building and the Town would sell the current Finance offices.

Rodeo Goat is Coming to Addison



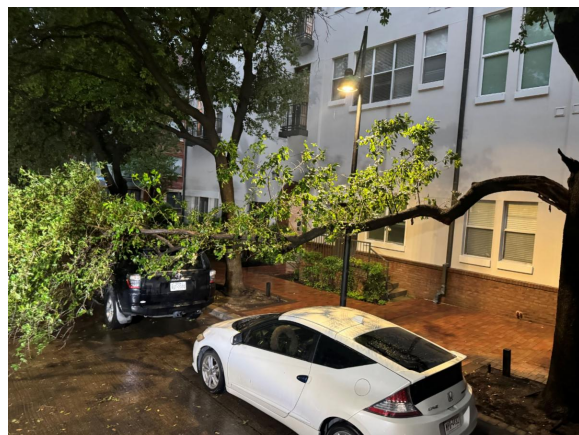
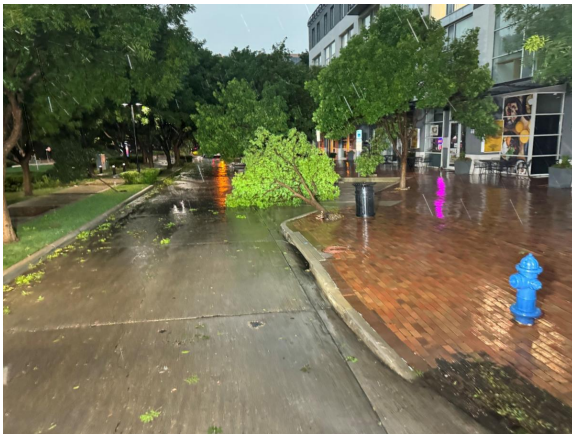
The City Council approved a Special Use Permit request for Rodeo Goat at its May 28 meeting. The new addition to Addison's dining scene will be located at 14901 Midway Road in the space formerly occupied by Spring Creek BBQ. Property updates include a 1,700-square-foot patio at the front of the building.

Rodeo Goat began in Dallas but has expanded throughout DFW. The interior of the restaurants exemplifies the atmosphere of a Texas rodeo and the menu features burgers, salads, sides, and desserts. The owners plan to open as soon as possible.

Around Town

Storm Clean-Up Efforts Could Take Up to Four Weeks



On Tuesday, May 27, North Texans were hit with a storm packing 75-mile-per-hour winds that caused widespread power outages, downed trees, and localized flooding. Since then, the Town's Public Works & Engineering and Parks & Recreation Departments have been working hard to repair the damage to the community. They have been addressing safety issues first and focusing on the hardest-hit areas of town. Addison Circle Park was hit especially hard, so they have also been assisting with restoring the site for Taste Addison this weekend.

The Town staff is aware of downed trees throughout parks, trails, and rights of way and is

working diligently to address these areas. However, clean-up efforts are anticipated to take three to four weeks.

Please also expect delays of up to two weeks in bulk trash collection while crews focus on restoration efforts. This includes brush and tree trimmings. As a reminder, if you want the Town to remove brush, it needs to be less than 6 feet long and neatly stacked out of the roadway. Learn more at addisontexas.net/bulktrash.

Upcoming Tollway Closures



Full Southbound Tollway Closure Planned for Friday, May 31 at 10pm - Monday, June 3 at 5am from I-635 to Walnut Hill Lane

All lanes of southbound Dallas North Tollway (DNT) from I-635 to Walnut Hill Lane will be closed from Friday, May 31 at 10pm to Monday, June 3 at 5am.

Other associated closures include:

- East- and westbound I-635 to southbound DNT direct-connector ramps
- Southbound Harvest Hill Road, Inwood Road, Forest Lane, and Royal Lane entrance ramps.
- Southbound Royal Lane exit ramp.
- Northbound left lane of DNT from Park Lane to Royal Lane.
- All lanes of east- and westbound Meaders Lane over the DNT.

Addison Airport Toll Tunnel Closed Nightly from May 28 - June 13

The NTTA is planning east- and westbound nightly closures of the Addison Airport Toll Tunnel for tunnel upgrades from May 28 - June 13 (8pm to 6am). The tunnel will be open Friday, May 31 and Saturday, June 1 for Taste Addison.

Detours:

- Eastbound detour: Drivers will turn right onto Midway Road and then make a left onto Belt Line Road. They will turn left onto Addison Road and make a right to continue eastbound on Keller Springs Road.
- Westbound detour: Drivers will turn right onto Addison Road and continue north to Trinity Mills Road, where they will turn left. They will turn left onto Midway Road and make a right to continue westbound on Keller Springs Road.
