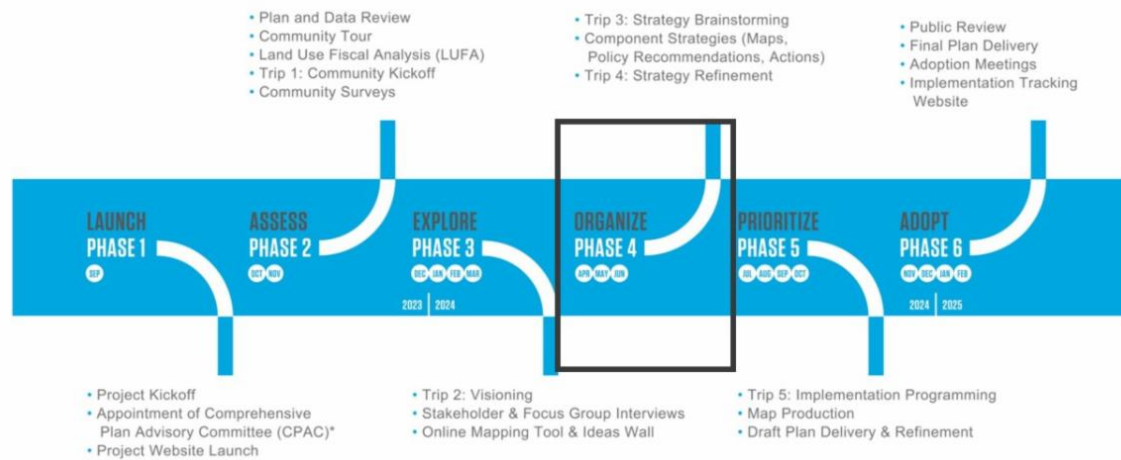
Upcoming Public Hearings

The following public hearings will be held during the July 16 Planning & Zoning Commission Meeting. Meetings are held at the Addison Conference Centre, 15650 Addison Road, and agendas are posted [on the Town's website](#) three days prior.

- Case 1918-SUP/Jewish Family Services of Greater Dallas. Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request for a Special Use Permit (SUP) for property located at 16301 Quorum Drive, that is currently zoned Commercial-1 (C-1), to allow a philanthropic institution.
- Case 1916-SUP/Greenhill Athletic Performance Center. Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request for a Special Use Permit (SUP) for an existing private school, Greenhill School, located at 4141 Spring Valley Road, currently zoned R-1 Single Family Dwelling and Planned Development (PD), through Ordinance 084-092, to allow a new private school building.
- Case 1903-Z/Suburban Studio Extended Stay (4545 Belt Line Rd). Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request to amend the permitted uses and approval of development plans for Planned Development (PD) District, Ordinance No. 089-015, for a 0.64± acre property located at 4545 Belt Line Road, to allow an extended stay hotel.

Wrapping up Phase 4 of Advance Addison 2050

The Advance Addison 2050 Comprehensive Plan project wrapped up Phase 4 at the July 11 joint City Council, Planning and Zoning Commission, and Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee (CPAC) meeting. During the meeting, a summary of the vision development process and results were presented. Improvements Planned for Spruill Dog Park



In the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 budget, the City Council allocated funds to install artificial turf in Spruill Dog Park. However, a survey revealed that users preferred natural turf, despite the need for regular closures for maintenance and rain. Since there was no support for artificial turf, staff was directed to use a portion of the funds to improve storm drainage in the park,

connect the pet drinking fountains to the sanitary sewer system, plant additional shade trees, and replace the drinking fountains.

Bids have been received, and a contract is being authorized, with work expected to start in August. A timeline will be provided to park users once it is established, and a temporary dog park will be built adjacent to the existing dog park so that pet owners will have access to an off-leash area while the work is taking place. The park will be resodded after construction is complete.

Thank you for your patience as we work to improve Spruill Dog Park.

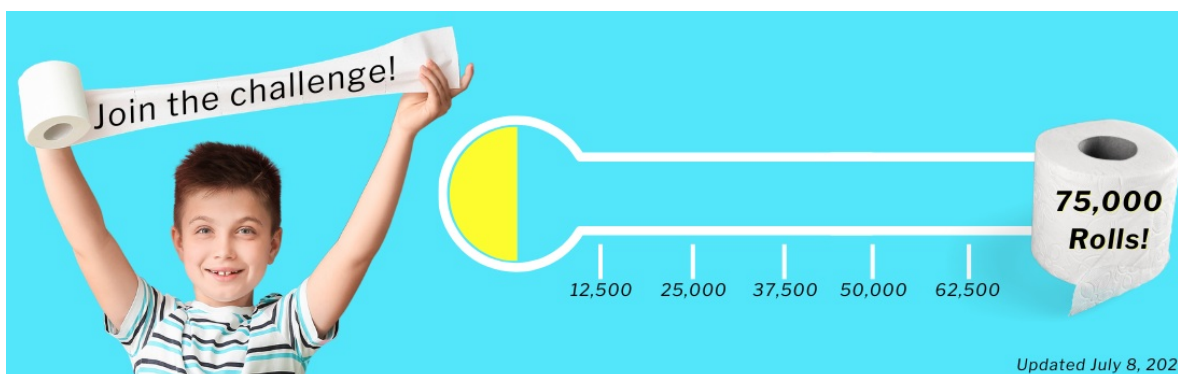
Cranking Up the Heat: Indoor Activities in Addison

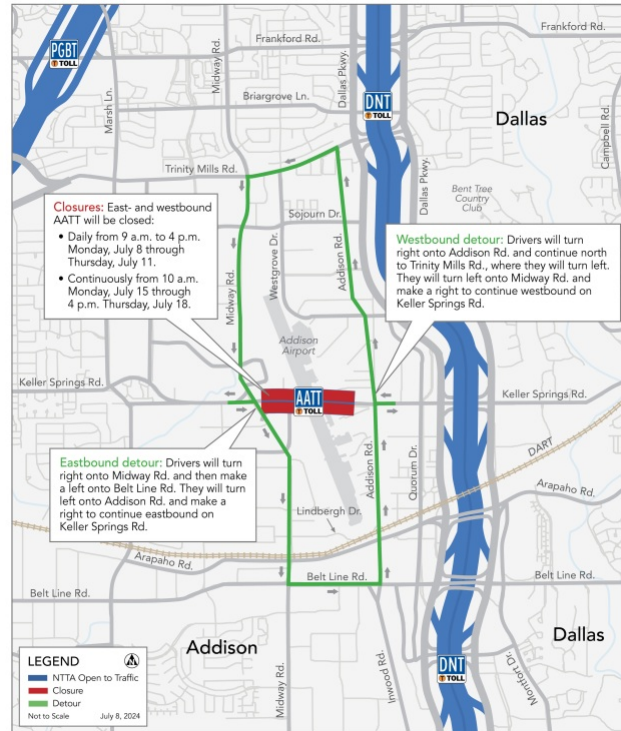
Danika

Construction Corner

Daily Airport Toll Tunnel Closures Planned Through July 18



The Addison Airport Toll Tunnel will be closed to traffic between 10am - 4pm from July 15 - 18. Please consider the following detours:

- **Eastbound detour:** Drivers will turn right onto Midway Road and then make a left onto Belt Line Road. They will turn left onto Addison Road and make a right to continue eastbound on Keller Springs Road.
- **Westbound detour:** Drivers will turn right onto Addison Road and continue north to Trinity Mills Road, where they will turn left. They will turn left onto Midway Road and make a right to continue westbound on Keller Springs Road.

New Traffic Signals at Midway Road and Belt Line Road

The new traffic signals at the Midway Road and Belt Line Road intersection are scheduled to be activated on Monday, July 15, from 9am to 3:30pm. During this time traffic will have a red flashing light in all directions, requiring all vehicles to stop at the intersection. There will also be various lane closures as final adjustments to the lights are completed.

Drivers can expect heavy traffic and delays while moving through the intersection during this time. Additionally, drivers should pay close attention to the traffic control and lane assignments in this area and obey all construction and directional signage at the intersections.

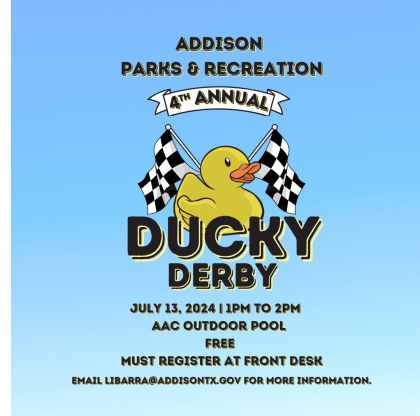
