DART CEO Provides Update to City Council

At the August 13 City Council meeting, Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) President and CEO Nadine Lee presented an update on several key initiatives, including the Addison Station, security measures, seamless mobility, strategic partnerships, and the Silver Line project. She emphasized Addison's significance within the network. The Addison Transit Center is served by 12 routes, has the second-highest ridership of any location in the DART bus network, and has achieved 95% of its pre-pandemic ridership levels.

Metrocrest Services Presents Funding Request for Fiscal Year 2025



During the August 13 City Council meeting, Metrocrest Services CEO Tracy Eubanks shared

some statistics about how the organization has supported Addison residents over the past year, as well as plans for next year. Based on the numbers to date below, Metrocrest Services projects that they will support more than 1,300 Addison residents in 2024:

- 85 Addison households received rent and utility assistance, totaling \$95,310 in emergency financial support.
- 1,075 Addison residents received nutritious food (133,600 pounds of food provided, creating 112,224 meals).
- 111 Addison households have received financial education and learned how to better manage their finances.
- 121 Addison residents have received workforce development services.

Metrocrest Services also provides homelessness support services. This fiscal year, their street outreach team has served 52 unsheltered residents and 6 households (20 individuals) received diversion services. The organization has recently placed a <u>form on its website</u> where the public can share information with the outreach team if they are concerned someone may be experiencing homelessness.

Jewish Family Service to Relocate to Addison

The Addison City Council approved a Special Use Permit at its August 13 meeting to allow Jewish Family Service (JFS) of Greater Dallas to relocate to the Parkside Corporate Center at 16301 Quorum Drive and expand their service offerings at one location. JFS is a nonsectarian nonprofit organization with a long history of providing social services in Addison and the surrounding communities. It has been located at 5402 Arapaho Road (southwest corner of Arapaho Road and Montfort Drive) for the past 23 years and supports all individuals regardless of age, race, religion, or ability to pay.

The Addison offices will be the primary location for the JFS administrative offices and will also provide four core services:

• **Physical Health:** Physical health will include a medical clinic that provides primary and preventative healthcare. The clinic is open to everyone and accepts most health insurance. JFS hopes to expand these services in the future to include additional

medical and/or dental care.

- Emotional Health: Emotional health is provided for all ages. This may include counseling and support for a variety of mental health illnesses and trauma.
- **Nutritional Health:** A food pantry is provided on-site for individuals seeking food assistance. This is a service that individuals must qualify for. The food pantry has limited hours of operation and is by appointment only.
- Financial Health: Career and financial services are offered to those individuals who need support to become income-stable or develop job skills via coaching or skills courses.

There will be approximately 60 employees on site initially, with an anticipated growth to 85-120 employees.

Holiday Tree Returns to Addison Circle



At the August 13 City Council meeting, the Council directed staff to move forward with planning for several holiday activities including a 32-foot holiday tree with a 6-foot branded riser and accessory decorations, a Tree Lighting Ceremony scheduled for December 6, and weekend carriage rides in the Addison Circle District.

This decision comes in response to numerous community requests to reinstate the holiday tree and event that MAA had hosted in Beckert Park. Although MAA continues to fund seasonal lighting along Quorum Drive, the holiday tree and associated events were canceled in 2018 due to repeated vandalism.

Bulk Trash Collection Pushed to Early Morning Hours Due to Heat

To provide our residents with the highest level of service while also ensuring a safe working environment for our employees, bulk trash collection will begin next week as early as 6am due to the extreme heat. Starting earlier allows our team to work during the cooler hours of

the morning, reducing the risk of heat-related health issues.

You can request bulk trash pick-up <u>on the Town's website</u>. Please allow a minimum of 48 business hours (Monday - Thursday, 6am - 4:30pm) for collections. Emergencies and special job operations may delay field crew response time.

Spruill Dog Park to be Closed from August 26 Until Middle of October for Improvements



Spruill Dog Park will be closed for construction from August 26 until the middle of October for improvements. The Town is improving drainage for the park, along with installing three new freeze-proof water fountains that will be connected to a nearby sanitary sewer system. This will alleviate the need for overflow "sumps" filled with gravel adjacent to the fountains which contributed significantly to the ongoing drainage issues at the park. Upon completion of the drainage project, Town staff will plant approximately 15 new four-caliper-inch trees and replace all sod in both the large and small dog parks. After a two-week period of sod watering and establishment, the parks are expected to re-open in mid-October.

A temporary dog park is being built adjacent to the existing dog park so that pet owners will have access to an off-leash area while the work is taking place. *Drinking water will not be available during construction so all guests are asked to bring drinking water for themselves and their pets.*
